Executive Order

The Anti-Corruption Commission in exercise of the power conferred upon it by Section 38 (8) and Section 171 of the Anti-Corruption Act of Bhutan 2011 has revised the Gift Rules 2009 and the Asset Declaration Rules 2012. The revision was done in close consultation with the relevant stakeholders. The Rules are part of the overall anti-corruption strategy to promote transparency, accountability and responsibility in the governance.

Following the revision, the Anti-Corruption Commission hereby adopts the following rules:

- (i) The Gift Rules 2017; and
- (ii) The Asset Declaration Rules 2017.

These revised Rules shall be enforced with immediate effect.
