Executive Order

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 (3) and 171 of the Anti-Corruption Act of Bhutan 2011, has revised the existing the Debarment Rule 2019 and hereby adopts the Debarment Rule 2023 on 9th December 2023 corresponding with the International Anti-Corruption Day, 2023.

The Rule was revised to address the anomalies faced in implementation. It aims to promote the conduct of government businesses with responsible entities or individuals and inculcate and foster integrity within contractual activities, particularly in the construction and supply of goods and services to ensure clean and transparent public procurement. Further, it is aimed at ensuring responsible management of public funds and services to guard against fraud, corruption, and unethical conduct by firms and individuals involved in public finance projects.
