Notification on the requirement for Integrity Vetting Report (IVR) for Professions Prone to Corruption Risks

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC), pursuant to Sections 24(1)(a) and (j), and 25(1)(h) of the Anti-Corruption Act of Bhutan 2011, and the Rules for Integrity Vetting 2024, hereby notifies all government agencies, state-owned enterprises, financial institutions, and civil society organizations to obtain an IVR for professions identified as prone to corruption risks. The list of such professions is enclosed with this notification.

This initiative is introduced to support agencies in strengthening good governance and enhancing integrity in human resource management practices. Accordingly, with effect from **1 July 2026**, all concerned agencies are required to obtain an IVR for positions/professions categorized as prone to corruption risk.

For other professions not included in the list, agencies are encouraged to voluntarily seek IVRs from the ACC.

All requests for IVRs shall be routed through the designated focal officer of the respective agency.
